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Tulip crochet pattern

Translated by Daniëlle Grondman – Amigurumi Designs by Dani

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Materials:

3mm crochet hook.
Yarn: light green, middle green, pink.
Safety eyes (There isn't a size in the pattern)
Scissors.
Needle and embroidery thread (black and red)
Fiber filling.
Flower pot (approx. Ø 7cm)

The tulip is approx. 17cm high.

Abbreviations

Ch	=	Chain
Sl st	=	Slip stitch
Sc	=	Single crochet
Inc	=	Increase (2 sc's in sc)
2tog	=	2 single crochets together
BLO	=	Back loop only
(..) x..	=	Everything between (..) is crocheted as much as behind x..

Color chart

This color chart will make it easier to choose a different color scheme.

Color	Pattern parts
Light green	Body and main parts
Middle green	Leaves
Pink	Tulip



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Body (in light green and pink yarn)

Fill the body with fiber filling along the way.

Light green yarn:

- Round 1: Magic circle 8 sc's (8)
- Round 2: (inc) x8 (16)
- Round 3: (sc 1, inc) x8 (24)
- Round 4: (sc 2, inc) x8 (32)
- Round 5: (sc 3, inc) x8 (40)
- Round 6: BLO: sc all (40)
- Round 7-15: sc all (40)
- Round 16: (sc 6, 2tog) x5 (35)
- Round 17: (sc 5, 2tog) x5 (30)
- Round 18: (sc 4, 2tog) x5 (25)
- Round 19: (sc 3, 2tog) x5 (20)
- Round 20: (sc 2, 2tog) x5 (15)
- Round 21: (sc 1, 2tog) x5 (10)

Now you'll start with the head.

- Round 22: (inc) x10 (20)
- Round 23: (inc) x20 (40)
- Round 24: (sc 4, inc) x8 (48)
- Round 25: (sc 7, inc) x6 (54)
- Round 26-33: sc all (54)
- Round 34: (sc 7, 2tog) x6 (48)
- Round 35: (sc 6, 2tog) x6 (42)

Place the eyes between round 30 and 31. Keep 8 stitches free between the eyes.

- Round 36: (sc 5, 2tog) x6 (36)
- Round 37: (sc 10, 2tog) x3 (33)
- Round 38: (sc 9, 2tog) x3 (30)
- Round 39: (sc 8, 2tog) x3 (27)
- Round 40: (sc 7, 2tog) x3 (24)
- Round 41: (sc 6, 2tog) x3 (21)
- Round 42: (sc 5, 2tog) x3 (18)
- Round 43: (sc 4, 2tog) x3 (15)
- Round 44: (sc 3, 2tog) x3 (12)
- Round 45: (sc 2, 2tog) x3 (9)
- Round 46-53: sc all (9)

Change to pink yarn. Now you'll start with the tulip.

- Round 54: (inc) x9 (18)
- Round 55: (sc 1, inc) x9 (27)
- Round 56-64: sc all (27)

Fasten off, leave a long tail.

Skip 8 stitches, weave the tail through the next stitch (1). Skip 8 stitches, weave the tail through the next stitch (2). Now weave the tail through the first stitch of round 64 (3) and pull tight.

Now you have 3 openings of 8 sc's. Sew each opening together with 4 stitches.



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Arms (make 2x in light green yarn)

Fill the arms with fiber filling along the way.

I couldn't find the pattern of the arms, but looking at the pictures I would advise:

Round 1: Magic circle 8 sc's (8)

Round 2-9: sc all (8)

Push round 9 flat. Crochet through 2 stitches at once to close the arms.

Do this with 4 sc's.

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the arms between round 21 and 22 of the body.

Leaf (make 2x in middle green yarn)

Work around the chain.

Round 1: chain 11

Round 2: sc 10, ch 2, go on to the other side of the chain, sc 10, ch 1 (12)

Fasten off with a sl st in the ch where you made your first sc. Leave a long tail.

Sew the leaves between round 45 and 49 of the body.

Eyebrows, lashes and mouth (in black and red embroidery thread)

For the eyebrows and lashes: use black yarn.

For the mouth: use red yarn.

Look at the pictures below for the placing and shape of all the parts.



I wish you lots of fun with your tulip!
