

Betty the Bear upgrade pattern



To make Betty the Bear, you need the pattern of Benny the Bear.

This design is older and still made with acrylic yarn and an 3.0mm crochet hook. I didn't weigh the yarn at that time. My advice is to use Scheepjes Softfun or Stone Washed yarn for this design.

Materials:

- 2.5mm crochet hook.
- Old pink and beige yarn.
- Scissors.
- Yarn needle.
- White felt.
- 1 fake eyelash. (optional; not childproof)
- Fiber filling.

Betty the Bear is approx. 17cm high when made with Softun or Stone Washed yarn.

Yarn information:

- Do you use other yarn?
- This can affect the size of the amigurumi.
- Adjust the size of the safety eyes to your yarn.



Abbreviations:

- Ch = Chain
- Sl st = Slip stitch
- Sc = Single crochet
- Inc = Increase (2 sc's in 1 stitch)
- (.) x. = Everything between (.) is crocheted as many times as the number after x

Yarn color	Pattern parts
Old pink	Body and main parts
Beige	Snout, feet soles

Eye white (make 2x in white felt)

Cut 2 ovals out of the white felt. Cut a small hole in the felt (black dot on picture). Push the 12mm safety eyes through the holes and attach them to the head.



Eyelids (make 2x in old pink yarn)

Round 1: Chain 4, turn
Round 2: inc, sc 1, inc (5)

Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.

Cut the fake eyelash in half.

Glue on round 2 of both eyelids an half eyelash. Pay attention that the eyelashes are curled to the outside.

Let the glue dry.

The position of the eyelids decides the emotion in Betty's face. You can experiment with this.

I sew the eyelids diagonal above the eyes between round 7 and 12 of the head.



Feet soles (make 2x in beige yarn)

Work around the chain.

Round 1: Chain 5
Round 2: sc 3, 3 sc's in 1 ch, go on to the other side, sc 2, 2 sc's in 1 ch (10)
Round 3: inc, sc 2, (inc) x3, sc 2, (inc) x2 (16)
Round 4: sc 1, inc, sc 2, (sc 1, inc) x3, sc 2, (sc 1, inc) x2 (22)

Fasten off with a slip stitch, leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the soles between round 4 and 5 of the feet.
